This will be followed by a light supper and refreshments in the Church hall and a short talk by one of our regiment's personalities. A selection of artefacts will be on display for guests to view and ask questions. The aim of this event is to continue to raise funds for the upgrade and modernisation of the museum within the Castle Keep due to commence in 2017.

Guests are able to park in the upper car parks adjacent to the Church. There are disabled access and toilet facilities. The Church, although heated, is quite cold so guests are advised to dress warmly.

The Snowdown Colliery Welfare Band will be playing for us during the service.

The cost of the tickets for this event are priced at £12 per adult and children £5, which includes supper, refreshments and car parking. Guests are limited to 200 so tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
